- > Always wear a cycle helmet.
- > We believe this activity is generally suitable for ages 12 and above (i.e young people who would normally find their own way to school etc). But it is your Parents/Guardians decisions.
- > If you can get together with other scouts and ride together, its more fun.
- > Under 12's of course can take part but we strongly recommend with a responsible older person.
- > Take a phone with you.
- > Take a small repair kit and know how to do simple tasks like putting a chain back on. If there is a bike lane please use it.
- > Be bright, high vis vest is not necessary, but a bright top makes such a difference to your visibility to other traffic.
